"Dependent origination

The myth that the autonomous ego is master of its own destiny is a delusion that leads to lack of co-operation, conflict and lonely isolation. The Buddha

offered us many opportunities to recognise the falsity of our widespread belief in an inherent existence.

By examining how we continue to believe in ourselves as a separate entity despite all evidence to the contrary, we will be able to recognise the emptiness of all phenomena including ourselves.

We will have plenty of time for practice."
